

**AMC Worcester Chapter
Leadership Scholarship Guidelines**
December 18, 2004

Eligibility for Full Scholarships

- All members of the Executive Committee
- Active Leaders
- Active Co-Leaders

The Leadership Chair-person has the discretion on who receives a scholarship for training, based on activity level and annual budget.

Scholarships will be awarded based upon initial or re-certification requirements

Reimbursement for training that is required for Leadership status gets first priority.

Reimbursement of Co-Leaders may be delayed until Leader status is obtained.

Types of Scholarships

- Mountain Leadership School (MLS)
- Leadership Training Institute (LTI)
- Wilderness First Aid (WFA)
- Other Leadership specific classes
- CPR

Requirements:

- The person must be a current member of the AMC, Worcester Chapter.
- A written request must be submitted to the Leadership Chair, which specifies the type of scholarship, the reason for the request, and the goals of the person making the request.
- Active leaders are those leaders who have led or co-led at least one hike for the chapter in the past 12 months.

Method of Scholarship Reimbursement:

- Participant pays for the course, which is reimbursed after the course is completed.
- Proof of payment and a copy of the completion certificate should be sent to the Leadership Chair within 30 days of completing the class for reimbursement.
- If a person is not an active leader at the time of the training, arrangements can be made for a delayed reimbursement at the discretion of the Leadership Chair.
